AVDR Tutorial for Dentists by the Center for Health Improvement and Prevention Studies - University of California San Francisco - 2005

15-minute interactive program contains instruction tailored to dentists and other oral health professionals in performing AVDR (Ask, Validate, Document and Refer) Intervention for victims of domestic violence.
